## Duty of Care Before and After School

Parents have the duty of care for students travelling to and from school. This means it is the parent's responsibility to ensure their child arrives safely to and from school. Absences will be followed up by a letter if no reason is given for the absence.

Schools are responsible for duty of care of students once in the school grounds during school operating hours. **Unless** children are attending organised **Before School Activities**; at our school, children are asked to come to school from 8.30am when the classroom doors are opened. If children come to school prior to 8.30am they are asked to sit in the undercover area until 8.30am when their teacher opens the classroom door. After school, it is expected that children make their way home straight away **unless** under the supervision of parents, for example, playing on the Parklands Nature Playground. Please remember that only children in Kindergarten or Pre-primary, **under parental supervision**, may play in the Pre-primary grounds after school.

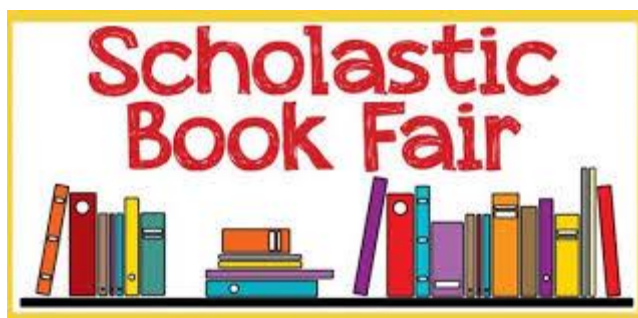
Membership forms with the \$1 membership fee can be dropped into the P&C box in the Front Office to passed on at School Banking on Friday mornings.













