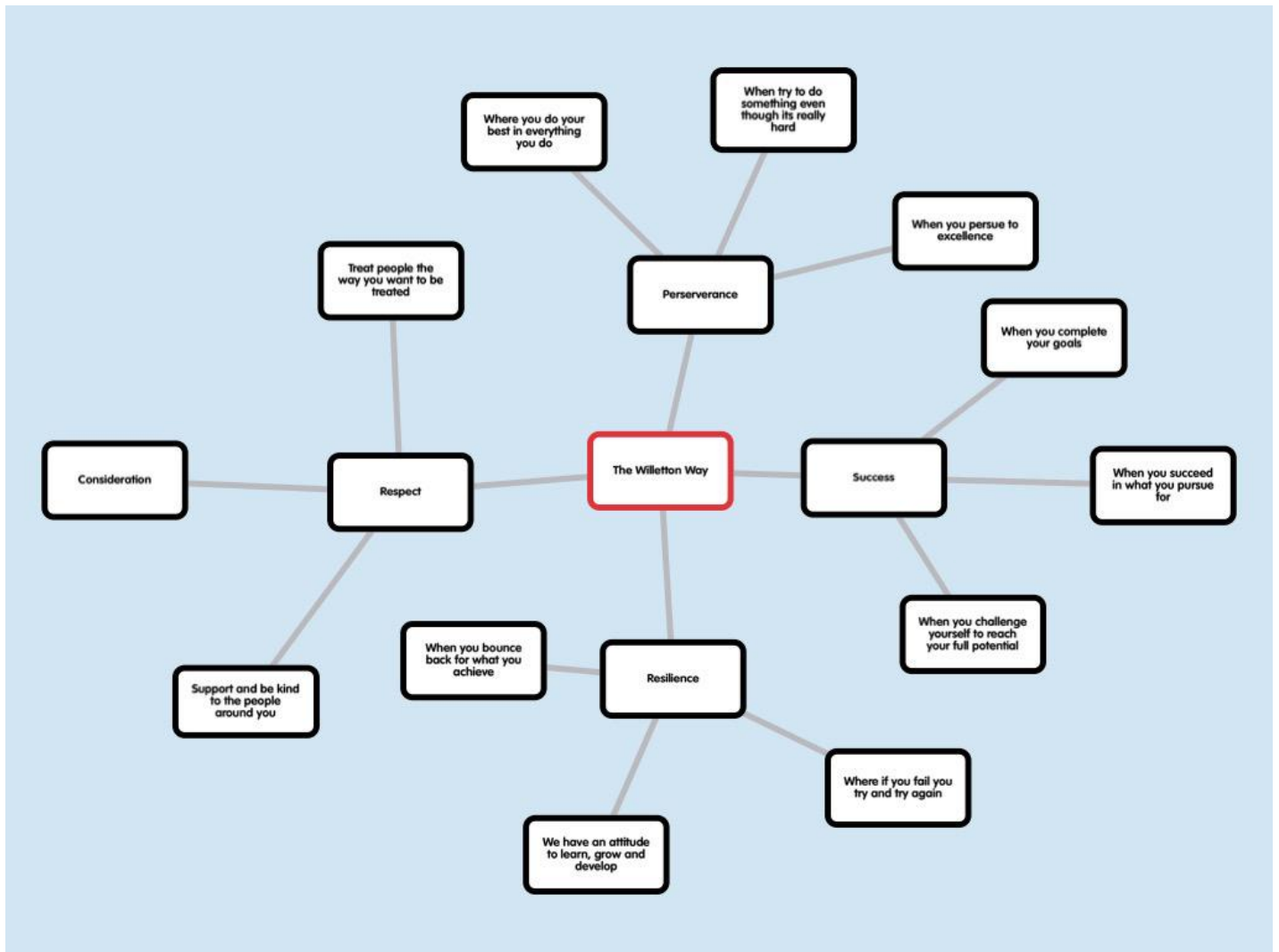

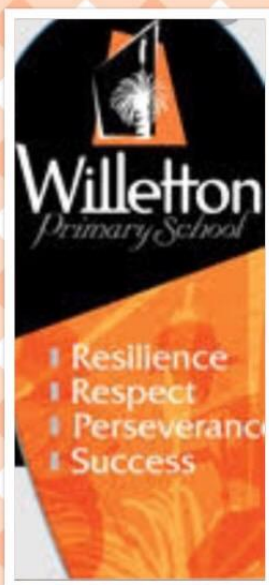




**Success:**
