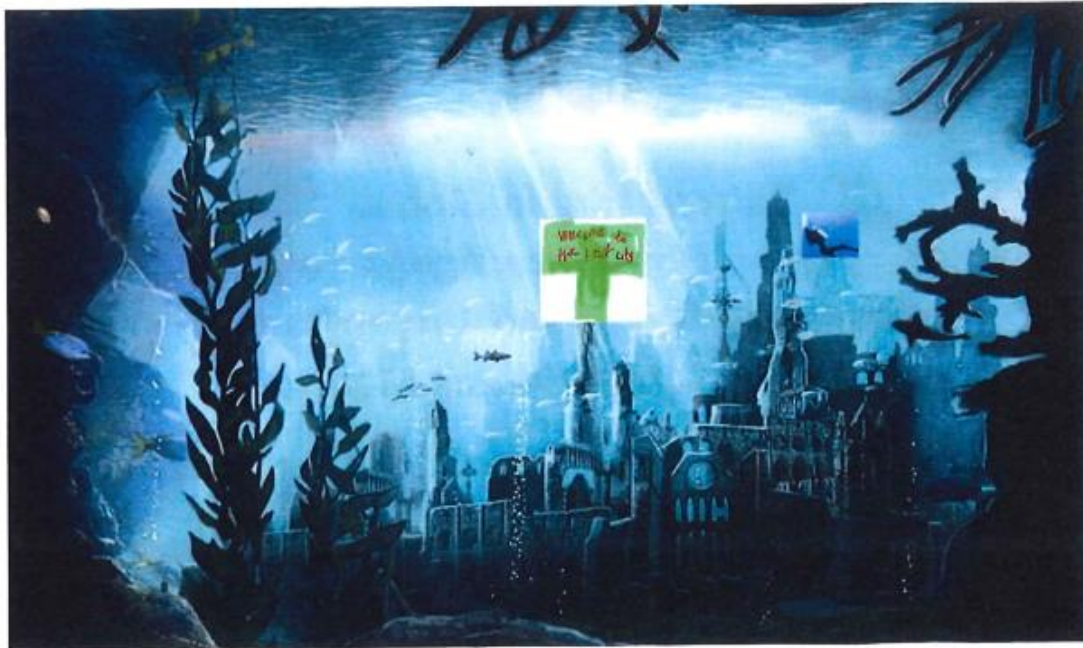
Myth Of The Lost City
